## Consultation carried out October to December 2021

A major decision on the future of Birdcage Walk will require the approval of our members in a vote. We have been consulting with members to find out their views about the future of the building – both to hear your opinion on this proposal and hear other options you may favour. We would like to thank everyone who has taken their time to share their views with us.

Following the publication of the proposal to grant a 250-year lease on 3 Birdcage Walk in September, we embarked on this consultation with the aim of engaging with as many members as possible. We are keen to hear your views and concerns about the plan and want to ensure you have sufficient information to make an informed decision.

The consultation included presentations to Boards and Committees by members of the Real Estate Strategy Group, as well as webinars, social media, and a podcast.

Discussions were also held at most membership boards, either to direct members to go and look at the Birdcage Walk website or with further debate.
