Immigration advice in the UK is regulated by the Office of the Immigration Services Commissioner (OISC). Due to the complex nature of such matters, any immigration advice must be provided by an immigration adviser who is approved and regulated by the OISC. There are free resources such as [Citizens Advice Bureau](#), some local law centres and an [adviser finder here](#).

The [Law Society of England and Wales](#) and the [Law Society of Scotland](#) are also able to provide a list of solicitors who are able to advise on Immigration. Information on this can be found in the “Find a Solicitor” area on their websites.
