With Dr Jundika's appointment, reformative actions and plans were made in transforming the IMechE UTP SC. The ultimate goal is to be

one of the most active clubs in UTP as well as one of the role models of IMechE SC's in Malaysia.

Under his leadership, a new board of committee was elected and they were eager to work alongside with him. With Dr Jundika's flow of ideas as well as the board's proficiency in execution, the SC bloomed and flourished within the span of a year. Dr Jundika's undivided support for the SC and its committees were well reflected with the activities conducted by the SC. The IMechE UTP SC was nominated for the UTP Student Excellence Appreciation Awards in the Outstanding Student Club/Society category for the first time in the student chapter's history.

Past Events

1.0 South East Asia Region (SEAR) Speak Out for Engineering (SOFE) Competition

The SEAR SOFE event 2019 was held in Asia Pacific University of Technology & Innovation (APU) on the 12^{th} October 2019.

The event was led by SEA Regional Young Members Representative Mr. Chua Yaw Long and the SEAR Chair, Prof Dr Ir Ts Vinesh Thiruchelvam, with the active support from the IMechE Malaysia Branch and APU's IMechE Student Chapter. The event was managed by APU's IMechE Student Chapter committee members, with the assistance of their Academic Liaisons Officer (ALO), Dr Arun Seeralan Balakrishnan and Dr Yvette Shaan-Li Susiapan, who also served as the emcee of the event. Three judges from different industrial backgrounds were invited to assess the participant's communications skills on effectively conveying technical topics of engineering to someone of nontechnical background. The judges were Ms Audrey L Fernando, Mr Brian Cracknell and Dr Rahmat Shazi.

The SEAR SOFE 2019 had six participants from the region:

- Christie Tan Shi Min from Singapore, presented on "Solar City" where she talked about using solar energy to power up homes in Singapore and how it is economically better.
- Teoh Hao Yang from Malaysia talked about "Safety in Modern Formula One Competitions". He spoke about how safety in Formula One has changed over the years and how it has affected the event, the lives of races and the public as well.
- Aaron Lim Wen Cong from Singapore, talked about the "Physics of Music" and how it can affect human emotions. He also carried out a demonstration live, with some props that he brought with him.
- Aidan Koh Yong Meng from Brunei talked about "Forest Fires", and how it has affected the lives of people around the world. He also recommended a solution utilizing mobile devices and heat sensors, as well as water sprinkler systems to help combat the problem.
- Naim Zafran from Malaysia gave a speech on "The Modern Airline" and how flight has changed over the years and has affected the way people have travelled around the world.
- Mr. Tang Dun Hao from Brunei gave a speech on "Green Future". He spoke about a conceptual software idea which aims for a greener innovative environment.

2.0 World of Robotics National Championship, Malaysia

World of Robotics specializes in robotics and STEM education for students age 5-19 years old in collaboration with Ministry of Education Malaysia and Asia Pacific University's School of Engineering, a reputable well-established higher education institution in Malaysia. The event ran over three days in November 2019.

The APU IMechE student chapter and WRC event served as a platform for all the pre-school, elementary

and high school students in Malaysia to showcase their creativity and talent in robotics.

The objectives of the competition were:

- To provide opportunities for students from public, national and international schools to participate in a robotics competition.
- To promote robotics and STEM education
- To motivate and encourage students from age 5-19 years old to learn and demonstrate their skills and tenants in robotics education.
- To cultivate young talents in robotics and stem education
- To prepare younger generations towards industrial revolution now and future
- As a general platform for students from all walks of life to participate in national robotics competition.
- An annual event that gather talents in robotics education and celebrate the achievement and participations of the students particularly.

This robotic competition differs from other robotics competition in several ways:

 Firstly, it is a competition that provided opportunities for all pre-school and elementary students because the materials for the competition were prepared by the organisers and the IMechE student members; the schools are not

require to purchase expensive robotics tools for the participation.

 Secondly, the students were given classes in robotics engineering with the competition as a platform for them to demonstrate and apply what they had learnt.

The playing field for the competition was only revealed on the day of the competition and not beforehand. This was to ensure a fair competition for all participants. The participants were not allowed to pre-program or pre-build their robots. Everything was to be done on the spot at APU. By doing so we can really see how well the student able to apply their skills in solving the mission and task of the competition by themselves.

The conducive environment of the host APU enabled the students to perform at their best. The World of Robotics National Championship had received good responses from schools, parents and students. During the event, 154 schools participated - the highest number ever. The robotic competition was successfully organised by IMechE student chapter members of APU which were led by Prof Dr Ir Ts Vinesh Thiruchelvam, the Deputy Vice Chancellor and the chapter's Academic Liaison Officer (ALO), Dr Arun Seeralan.
